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A national survey of those professing to be "born again", Bible believing Christians said that 70% of them do NOT believe that Jesus Christ is the only way to heaven. This, in spite of the words of our Saviour Himself. "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." John 14:6.

Did He really mean this? If He did, how can those who believer otherwise really be Christians? The answer is, They Can't!

Years ago I watched Katie Couric interviewing Jimmy Carter on the NBC morning news program. Carter had recently published a book of his adult Sunday School lessons. Couric asked Mr. Carter, point blank, "Do you believe that Jesus Christ is the only way to heaven." I fully expected him to take a decided stand for Christ, but I was sadly disappointed. His answer... "No! I don't believer Jesus is the only way to heaven." He went on

to say that the reason his Camp David accords were so successful was because Menachem Begin, Prime Minister of Israel and Egyptian President Anwar Sadat, all believed in the same God.



Here Carter, a professed Christian, Begin, an Israeli who did not believe in the Son of God, and Sadat, a Muslim, each one is said to believe in the same God. Does that mean that they are all going to heaven? Absolutely not!

"Thou believest that there is one God: thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble." James 2:19.

Jesus said, "I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I AM HE, ye shall die in your sins." John 8:24.

Was Jesus lying? NO! Of

course not. If He was telling the truth, then how could anyone who professes to be a true



believer in Christ as Saviour and Lord, believe that there is any other way to heaven?

Fatalism Disguised As Sovereign Grace

Fatalism (by definition), the attitude of mind which accepts whatever happens as having been bound or decreed to happen. Such acceptance may be taken to imply belief in a binding or decreeing agent. The development of this implication can be found in ancient Greek and Roman mythology, with its personification of Fate, and in Norse mythology with the Norns. -Encyclopedia Britannica-

John Calvin (1509-1564) admits that his theology was already developed by Augustine, so the question is then: How did Augustine arrive at his view of Predestination, which is quite the opposite of what was publicly taught within the church for the first 300 years of early church history. It should be noted that Augustine was himself a Gnostic Manichaean for nearly a decade before converting to Catholicism. Generally, it is thought that Augustine developed his theology on predestination after debating with Pelagius (354-420/440), in terms of the inevitability of personal evil and divine cosmic ordering (or divine sovereignty, if you will).

Consider one of the great followers of Calvin and Augustine, John Gill.

"In appointing Christ to be the Mediator and Surety of it, and putting the said promises and blessings into his hands, and so their persons, for safety and security; all of which were done in eternity." (Emphasis mine. ED)

"..the elect are reckoned as righteous, through the righteousness of Christ: and these being the objects of justification, show the eternity of that act, since election was from the beginning, and before the foundation of the world." (Emphasis mine. ED)

According to Gill, security "..from and condemnation.." wrath "predestinated" from before the foundation of the world. If this is true, then the elect were never, in any sense, actually lost. Yet God's Word says, "...in time past ve walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: Among whom WE ALL had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; AND WERE BY NATURE THE CHILDREN OF WRATH, EVEN AS OTHERS."

Gill further says, "The grand comprehensive promise, "even eternal life", (I John 2:25) and which is absolute and unconditional, with respect to them; whatever condition is in that covenant, lay only on Christ to perform; he and his work are the only condition of it." (Emphasis mine. ED)

If Salvation is "unconditional", why are sinners commanded to repent? (Acts 17:30). If Salvation is "unconditional", why are sinners commanded to believe in Christ as the only begotten Son of God, His finished work of redemption on the cross and His resurrection? (Romans 10:9-10, I Corinthians 15:1-4)

Unconditional Election and Absolute Predestination are dangerous doctrines because they would relieve the sinner of any responsibility toward God. Jesus said, "I tell you, Nay: but, except ve repent, ve shall all likewise perish." (Luke 13:3, 5). "..IF thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be *saved.*" (Romans 10:9)

Faith and Repentance ARE conditions!
